Updating existing copies of built-in skills and converting them into derived skills that use the latest version of the Technology Core is temporarily disabled. Limitations and known issues

In this release, there are the following new limitations and known issues that will be addressed in future releases:

Document and Classification skills

- Updating existing copies of built-in skills and converting them into derived skills that use the latest version of the Technology Core is temporarily disabled. Instead, you can create a derived skill from the corresponding built-in skill that uses the latest version of the Technology Core. Also, since updating of copies is disabled in this version, you can create new skills that will use Technology Core v. 2.0 straight away. This may be necessary in cases when you want to add a new Document skill to a Process skill that contains other Document skills based on Technology Core v. 2.0.
- Updating existing copies of built-in skills that use Technology Core v. 1.0 is temporarily disabled. Updating copies of built-in skills to the latest version of the Technology Core will become available once we add a feature to update copies of default skills in future releases.
- If your skill has a rule that enters in a value into a table row, it may add a new empty row to the table containing only that value. This issue also occurs in skills derived from the Invoice US built-in skill.
